**1. Committee Business**

Chair Murray called the meeting to order at 1:50 p.m.

**MOTION:** Sen. Walker moved to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2005 meeting. The motion passed unanimously. Sen. Mayne, Rep. Adams, Rep. Dougall, Rep. Dunnigan, Rep. Gibson, and Rep. Tilton were absent for the vote.

**2. Alternate Financing and Role of Public-Private Partnerships**

Mr. Steinagel distributed and reviewed "Public-Private Partnerships, Overview of Potential Legislation."

Ms. Linda Hull, Director, Legislative and Government Affairs, UDOT (Utah Department of Transportation), and Ms. Linda Bohlinger, HNTB Corporation, responded to questions from the Committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Murray moved to encourage legislation enabling public-private partnerships for financing transportation projects. The motion passed unanimously. Rep. Dougall and Rep. Hansen were absent for the vote.

**3. Highway Jurisdictional Transfer Task Force Report**

Sen. Walker reviewed the "Highway Jurisdictional Transfer Task Force Report," as contained in the mailing packet.

Mr. Carlos Braceras, UDOT, responded to questions from the Committee.

Mr. Lincoln Shurtz, Utah League of Cities and Towns, spoke in favor of draft legislation "Highway Transfer Process Amendments."

**MOTION:** Rep. Dee moved to recommend draft legislation "Highway Transfer Process Amendments." The motion passed unanimously. Rep. Adams, Rep. Dougall and Rep. Hansen were absent for the vote.

#### **4. Draft Legislation "Driving Under the Influence Amendments"**

**MOTION:** Rep. Daw moved to amend draft legislation "State Highway Amendments" as follows: On line 146, delete "Bountiful 400 North" and insert "the North Salt Lake". The motion passed unanimously. Sen. Jenkins, Rep. Adams, Rep. Dee, and Rep. Tilton were absent for the vote.
