S.B. 12 Age Limit for Tobacco and Related Products (*Sen. S. Reid*)

MOTION: Sen. Shiozawa moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 1, Line 27 through Page 2, Line 28:*

27 Other Special Clauses:

28 **{None} This bill takes effect on July 1, 2016.**

2. *Page 19, Lines 576 through 579:*

576 (iv) the name and description of the cashier or proprietor from whom the individual

577 attempted the purchase;

578 (v) the name and address of the retail establishment; and

579 (vi) the date and time of the attempted purchase.

Section 16. Effective date.

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2016.
