SB 12 Passenger Carrier Requirements (Sen. K. Mayne)

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to adopt **1st Sub SB 12**. The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Adams, Sen. Davis, Sen. Okerlund, and Sen. Weiler absent for the vote.

Sen. Mayne explained the bill to the committee.
