1. Committee Business

The following seven study items were prioritized by the Committee: Drug Treatment, Victim Reparation Process, Education and Illegal Drug Use in Prison, Statewide E-911 Emergency Services, Theft Prevention, Access to Juvenile Records, and Meth Lab Disclosure.
