3. Exemption from Nonresident Tuition

Legislation was introduced in the 2005 General Session to repeal a provision that, if allowed under federal law, exempts a student at a Utah institution of higher education from the nonresident portion of total tuition if the student attended high school in the state for three or more years and graduated from high school or received the equivalent of a high school diploma. The bill was considered by the House Education Standing Committee and referred to interim study. Utah institutions of higher education are currently granting the exemption to eligible students.
