

**RECOMMENDING AND RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTING PROPOSED

NO. 2 (EXHIBIT "A"), UTAH SENATE DISTRICT NO. 27 (EXHIBIT "B"), UTAH  
HOUSE DISTRICT NO. 69 (EXHIBIT "C"), AND SAN JUAN COUNTY  
COMMISSION REDISTRICTING (EXHIBIT "D") TO THE JOINT  
REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE OF THE UTAH LEGISLATURE.**

**Whereas:**


1. The Navajo Utah Commission was established by the Intergovernmental Relations Committee of the Navajo Nation Council by Resolution No. IGRJN-134-92 to develop and maintain efficient governmental services to the Navajo People residing on the "Utah Strip" of the Navajo Nation; and
2. Utah Navajos are citizens of the United States and the state of Utah with the right to vote and participate in all state and Congressional elections.; and
3. The Utah Legislature has appointed the Joint Redistricting Committee to address redistricting including Congressional and state legislative districts; and
4. The Utah Redistricting Committee conducted 18 public hearings but did not include a stop on the Navajo Reservation in southeastern Utah despite the existence of a language barrier and need to provide proper interpretation for a substantial percentage of Navajo voters; and
5. The U.S. Congress enacted the Voting Rights Act in 1965 to protect the voting rights of U.S. citizens including minority populations pursuant to Section 2 and Section 5; and
6. The Navajo Nation Council has authorized the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission to assist the Navajo Nation on all state legislative and Congressional redistricting activities; and
