Representative King moves that the legislative Redistricting Committee adopt the following principles for the 2011 redistricting process. Redistricting plans shall:

1. Comply with the federal and state Constitutions and the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. §1973 et. seq.;
2. Ensure that state legislative districts and school board districts have substantial equality of population among the various districts, with a deviation not greater than +/- 4%;
3. Ensure that congressional districts must be as nearly equal as practicable in the population among the various districts, with a deviation not great than +/- .5%;
4. Ensure that each district is contiguous;
5. Ensure that each district is reasonably compact; and
6. Congressional districts will be single member districts. Non-congressional districts may be either single member or multi-seat districts.

Representative King further moves that redistricting plans, to the degree reasonably achievable, strive to:

1. Maintain communities of common interest including keeping municipalities and townships intact and respecting existing city and county boundaries; and
2. Promote meaningful competition between political parties rather than single party districts which effectively silence the voice of the minority voter, regardless of party preference.
