Here are the updated redistricting statistics. These numbers are current as of 11:30 PM October 14, 2011.

Registered users: 969

Submitted Plans: 323

Of those plans that passed criteria...

Congress: 199

House: 24

Senate: 30

School Board: 18

This represents a dramatic increase in the number of submitted plans and registered users. There were 251 submitted plans and 780 users on September 26th. In the two and a half weeks since then, 72 plans were submitted (almost entirely Congressional plans) and 189 users registered with the software.

The number of registered users was 780 on September 26th.
