

By moving Rich and Cache Counties from district 1 to 2, district 1 would include all of Davis county and some of Salt Lake city. With less of district 2 in Salt Lake county, district 4 can move out of Davis county and include more of Salt Lake.

District 3 would not need to change. Utah county does no need to be split. By moving all of the counties in district 3 (but Utah county) to 4, district 3 would be all of Utah county and some of Salt Lake. District 4 would have less of Salt Lake county making a better balance of all the districts in Salt Lake county.

By moving Rich and Cache Counties from district 1 to 2, district 1 would include all of Davis county and some of Salt Lake city. With less of district 2 in Salt Lake county, district 4 can move out of Davis county and include more of Salt Lake. District 3 would not need to change. Utah county does no need to be split. By moving all of the counties in district 3 (but Utah county) to 4, district 3 would be all of Utah county and some of Salt Lake. District 4 would have less of Salt Lake county making a better balance of all the districts in Salt Lake county.
