Plan name: Fair 4 Utah Counties and Cities
Description: In the Fair 4 Utah plan all of the counties are whole except Salt Lake. Salt Lake county is mostly split into two districts with a small portion in the other two districts. All of the cities in Salt Lake county are whole except West Valley City and three others (South Salt Lake, Salt Lake City, and Herriman) with minor splits. As an example Salt Lake City is all in one district except about 100 people. District 2, 3, and 4 are at the target mean of 690,971. District 1 is one over at 690,972.
