It would make so much more sense to leave Grantsville together with the rural parts of Tooele County and combine Nephi with Delta, Ephraim and Manti. The district that stretches from northern Tooele County to Iron County is anything but compact. Reason and fairness have been thrown to the wind. This map is "Exhibit A" to show why legislators should not be drawing their own districts. The result is senseless, power-hungry, self-serving madness. I can only hope the Governor steps in with a veto.

With all due respect, this map goes completely out of whack as soon as it crosses the south Utah County line. District 67 is rediculously gerrymandered to continue to guarantee that the incumbent, (Rep. Painter, Mona) will have no serious competition even though his home county (Juab) is the smallest of the three counties included in this proposed district. How in the world does it make sense to reach all the way up to the northern end of Tooele county to get enough population for this district when it can be had so much more senseably, compactly, and logically by simply combining Sanpete and Juab into a single district? The numbers are perfect for that. I know it works because I and others have submitted maps that do exactly that.

It defies logic that this district needs to run in a narrow, very sparcely populated, illogical corridor that reaches clear up to northern Tooele County to collect enough population when the very population it needs is sitting on the door step in one of the counties the district is already proposed to be comprised of. The only logical explanation for such an artificial construct is that someone with a vested interest wants to see that this district is kept as non-competitive with tiny Juab as possible.

We thank the Committee for separating Sanpete and Carbon Counties as we requested. But if Sanpete must be divided, we urge the House to consider drawing the line further south and eliminating the gerrymandered north end of this proposed district that will serve to only anger and alienate the citizens of Sanpete and Tooele counties against any candidate that may emerge from Juab County, simply as a matter of principal. 



Why are the variances so low? It may not be a popular thing to do, but I think we should intentionally make some of the areas that are growing fast have smaller districts and some of the more established districts be larger. It will only take a couple of years for some of these districts to be GIANT again.
