

I like how this variant simplifies my proposal's boundaries, but I also wonder if this simplification is worth the price of dividing additional cities between different districts. Mine divided only three cities, namely Bountiful and Salt Lake City and Pleasant Grove. Perhaps it's worth this price---I simply don't know.

In any case, I thank Utah's legislators for giving this proposal (or something roughly like it) some serious consideration. I can't speak on behalf of it in person, but I invite others to visit the webpage linked above for a more thorough explanation of my reasoning behind it. As I've stated before, I think that it makes about as much sense as possible (considering the rules) from a purely geographical perspective.




