**HR3-2-510 Prohibited motions.**

- (1)
  - (a) Except for a motion to adjourn, a committee member may not make a motion unless a quorum of the standing committee is present.
  - (b) When a quorum is not present, a motion to adjourn is passed with a majority vote of those present.
- (2) No motion is in order during a vote.
- (3) A point of order is not in order during a vote.
- (4) A committee member may not make a motion to:
  - (a) strike the enacting clause of legislation;
  - (b) strike the resolving clause of a resolution;
  - (c) circle legislation; or
  - (d) place legislation on a time certain calendar.
