MOTION: Rep. Peterson moved to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2013 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow, Rep. McCay, and Rep. Moss absent for the vote.

S.B. 222 Transportation Amendments (*Sen. W. Harper*) (Rep. D. Ipson**)**

Sen. Harper introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Peterson moved to pass S.B. 222 out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Barlow and Rep. McCay absent for the vote.

H.B. 176 Utah Industrial Facilities and Development Act Amendments (*Rep. D. Brown*)
